INVITATION

It is our pleasure to invite you to participate in the International Scientific Conference “Conservation of animal genetic resources in Poland and in Europe – achievements and dilemmas” that will be held in Balice, Poland, which is near Krakow. The Conference will be convened 31st May – 2nd June 2007.

Thematic scope of the conference:

- The state of animal genetic resources and their characterization
- Conservation methods
- Legal and practical aspects of utilisation of conservation herds and their products
- Role of international cooperation in conservation of animal genetic resources

The conference programme will include:

- Invited papers and short communications
- A Poster session

Papers submitted for the conference (one copy in English and one copy in Polish) will be published in English in the Supplement of the Annals of Animal Science. The conditions of publishing include two positive reviews of the paper as well as a payment of the participation fee and publishing fee (270 PLN for each submitted paper). Abstracts (in Polish and in English) will be published in proceedings of the conference.

The Conference participation fee is 400PLN, which covers conference proceedings, all meals during the conference and a gala dinner. An additional 100PLN is being charged for participation in the conference tour that includes visits to research stations and sightseeing in Krakow.

We hope that days spent in Balice will result in scientific-based and practical suggestions for improving conservation efforts and enable a group of people who care for conservation of native livestock breeds in Europe to spend enjoyable time together sharing experiences.

INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS OF RESEARCH PAPERS

PUBLISHED IN THE “ANNALS OF ANIMAL SCIENCE SUPPLEMENT”

1. The “Annals of Animal Science Supplement” prints proceedings of international symposia and conferences that cover the following range of topics: genetics and farm animal breeding; the biology, physiology and reproduction of animals; animal nutrition and feedstuffs; environment, hygiene and animal production technology; economics and the organization of animal production.
2. Papers are printed in English.
3. Papers are reviewed by two reviewers who are research workers specializing in the relevant field. Papers are accepted for printing in the Supplement by the Scientific Editor (chair of conference or symposium) and the Editor-in-Chief of the “Annals of Animal Science”.
4. The paper to be printed (text plus tables, figures, photographs, references and Polish summary) should not exceed four A4 pages.
5. Manuscripts should be submitted in duplicate together with reviews and a diskette or a CD. The following requirements should be met: Word processor: Word for Windows; font: Times New Roman 12; margins: 25 mm (left, right, top, bottom); line spacing: double; tables: table function.
6. The paper should contain: the title of the paper (in capital letters), the full name(s) of author(s), the full name and postal address of the department where the study was carried out; and source of research financing (work financed from statutory activity, project no. ..., etc).
7. The paper should have the following layout:

Introduction. This should contain a clearly formulated aim of the study.

Material and methods. This section should contain basic information on experimental layout and number of animals.

Results can be presented in tabular or graphic form and given a brief description.

Discussion. This should interpret the results in terms of the influence of experimental factors according to the aim of the experiment or to the hypothesis made in the Introduction. The experimental results should be interpreted using the current state of knowledge to help the reader accept or reject the hypothesis tested. This section should conclude with a summing-up and generalization of the results obtained.

References. References (in English, if possible) cited in the text (10 references at most) must be organized in strict alphabetical order according to name of author. When a citation has more than two authors, the name of the first author should be followed with “et al.”.

Photographs of postcard size should have good contrast. Each figure or photograph should be provided with a brief description of its content.

Summary should be in English.

Key words. Maximum five items.

ABSTRACTS

Abstracts of the papers, max one A4 page long should be prepared both in English and in Polish. The following requirements should be met: Word processor: Word for Windows; font: Times New Roman 12; margins: 25 mm (left, right, top, bottom) and single line spacing.

The abstract should contain: the title of the paper (in capital letters), the full name(s) of author(s), the full name and postal address of the institution where the study was carried out.

The abstract should include clearly defined objective of the study, key information regarding experimental scheme and material and comprehensive summary and interpretation of results obtained.

The Authors are fully responsible for the content of the abstracts that will be printed without changes in the conference proceedings.
