PROGRAMME (PROVISIONAL)

Session 1:

Evaluation of sheep and goat farming systems and indicators of sustainability

Papers from the working group on evaluation; evaluation of pastoral systems, etc.

Session 2:

The role of sheep and goat production systems in natural protected

Co-existence with wild species (wolf, bear), shrub control and risk of fire, preservation of endemic plants and deterioration of potentiality of pasture

Session 3:

Attractiveness of sheep and goat farming activities and assessment of their economic valorization

Labour organisation, multi-activities (tourism, preservation of environment, local handicrafts), valorisation of local products (organic, protected denomination of origin - PDO - commercial organisation, etc.) and training.

CALL FOR PAPERS AND SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

Papers should be written in French or English. Abstracts (no more than 200 words) should be sent by 30th of April 2007.

All papers will be peer reviewed and, if accepted, they will be published in a special issue of the CIHEAM journal, Options Méditerranéennes.

The organization may also have its own publication.

At least, one author per paper must be registered in the Seminar.
